## ABOUT ROCKIT

A lot of our work takes place in Central London, but we operate across the UK wherever the work takes us. Day to day, we're a team of people who genuinely care about what we do and how we do it.

We hold a high standard and we stick to it. We're known for being the team that gets stuck in and makes things happen. The work we deliver matters, and we treat it that way.

There's a shared expectation that we deliver to a high standard every time. If something needs sorting, it gets sorted. The work can be fast-paced and high-pressure at times, with quick turnarounds and long days — but there's a good energy to it. People pull together, step up and look out for each other. Rockit isn't a place where you'll be left on your own - you'll be supported by the team around you. But it's also not somewhere you can sit back and coast; people here get stuck in, take ownership and care about doing things properly.

## HOW WE WORK

---

The work here moves quickly and doesn't always go to plan, so clear communication and a calm, practical approach make a big difference. We keep things straightforward. If something needs attention, it gets raised early and dealt with. People keep each other in the loop and work things through rather than letting them drift.

There's a level of ownership that comes with the role. People take responsibility for their work, think ahead and keep things moving, while also knowing when to bring others in for support. On site and in the office, the team is switched on, respectful and focused. Everyone plays their part, and there's a shared understanding of what good looks like.

It suits people who are organised, proactive and comfortable working at pace, and who enjoy being part of a team that works well together and wants to see each other do well.



## THE ROLE

---

As a **Driving Technician**, you'll take ownership of deliveries, collections and transport logistics, ensuring equipment arrives on time, in the right condition and ready for use. You'll play a key role in supporting project delivery, often working independently and acting as a visible representative of the business. This role is responsible for the safe, efficient and reliable movement of equipment across the business.

Alongside driving responsibilities, you'll support the warehouse and on-site teams — helping with equipment preparation, loading and unloading, and assisting with builds and de-rigs where required. This is a role with real responsibility. You'll be trusted to manage your time, maintain high standards and ensure everything runs smoothly across transport and logistics. You'll often work independently or with minimal supervision, so a strong sense of ownership, self-management and personal standards is essential. You'll be trusted to represent the business, manage your time effectively and ensure work is carried out properly, even when working alone.

## WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING

---

- Carrying out deliveries, collections and returns of equipment across London, the home counties and further afield
- Managing transport logistics, ensuring equipment is delivered on time and in the correct condition
- Loading and unloading vehicles safely and efficiently, taking responsibility for how equipment is handled and transported
- Ensuring all equipment is loaded and secured safely for transport
- Acting as a representative of the business when on the road and on site, maintaining a professional and approachable manner
- Taking responsibility for the upkeep, cleanliness and basic maintenance of company vehicles
- Supporting on-site teams with builds and de-rigs where required
- Supporting the warehouse with equipment preparation, returns and organisation
- Maintaining accurate paperwork and records relating to deliveries, collections and jobs
- Identifying and reporting issues with vehicles or equipment promptly
- Maintaining high standards of organisation, care and attention to detail
- Maintaining high personal standards in how you work, manage your time and represent the business, particularly when working independently
- Ensuring health & safety procedures are followed at all times

- Strong self-management and reliability, with the ability to maintain high standards without supervision
- Strong organisation and time management skills
- Ability to remain calm under pressure and adapt to changing situations
- A responsible and professional approach, with the ability to represent the business positively when working alone or on site
- A proactive attitude and willingness to take ownership of tasks and see them through properly
- Good communication skills and ability to work effectively with different people across the business
- Basic understanding of technical equipment (lighting, sound, video or staging)
- Comfortable with the physical nature of the role (manual handling, working at height)
- Understanding of the dynamic nature of the events industry

- Experience in a driving, logistics or delivery-based role
- Experience within live events or technical production
- Experience supporting on-site builds and working as part of an events team
- Basic electrical knowledge or experience working with technical equipment
- IPAF, First Aid or relevant industry qualifications
- Experience driving larger vehicles or working in busy urban environments
