ABOUT ROCKIT

Rockit is a technical event production company delivering lighting, sound and AV across a wide range of events, venues and clients. A lot of our work takes place in Central London, but we operate across the UK wherever the work takes us. Day to day, we're a team of people who genuinely care about what we do and how we do it.

There's a shared expectation that we deliver to a high standard every time. If something needs sorting, it gets sorted. The work can be fast-paced and high-pressure at times, with quick turnarounds and long days — but there's a good energy to it. People pull together, step up and look out for each other. Rockit isn't a place where you'll be left on your own - you'll be supported by the team around you. But it's also not somewhere you can sit back and coast; people here get stuck in, take ownership and care about doing things properly.

HOW WE WORK

The work here moves quickly and doesn't always go to plan, so clear communication and a calm, practical approach make a big difference. We keep things straightforward. If something needs attention, it gets raised early and dealt with. People keep each other in the loop and work things through rather than letting them drift.

There's a level of ownership that comes with the role. People take responsibility for their work, think ahead and keep things moving, while also knowing when to bring others in for support. On site and in the office, the team is switched on, respectful and focused. Everyone plays their part, and there's a shared understanding of what good looks like.

It suits people who are organised, proactive and comfortable working at pace, and who enjoy being part of a team that works well together and wants to see each other do well.



THE ROLE

As a **Live Events Technician**, you'll be responsible for preparing, installing and operating technical equipment across a wide range of events. You'll be trusted to deliver work to a high standard, represent the business on site and contribute to the overall success of each project. This role sits at the centre of delivery and plays a key part in how our work is experienced by clients.

You'll work across both the warehouse and on-site, ensuring equipment is prepared properly, delivered safely and operated confidently in live environments. Depending on the project, you may work as part of a team or take responsibility for smaller events independently. This is a hands-on role with real responsibility. You'll be expected to take ownership of your work, maintain high standards and apply strong technical knowledge in both planning and delivery. This role suits someone who is technically capable, reliable and takes pride in delivering work properly.

WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING

- Preparing equipment for projects, ensuring it is accurate, complete and ready to go
- Loading, unloading, building and de-rigging equipment across a range of events
- Operating technical equipment on site, applying strong technical knowledge and making sound decisions in live environments
- Delivering work to a high standard, whether working independently or as part of a team
- Supporting the delivery of events across lighting, sound, video and staging
- Maintaining and repairing equipment within the company's stockholding
- Working closely with Project Managers and Technical Project Managers to support delivery
- Taking responsibility for smaller projects where appropriate, depending on experience
- Maintaining high standards of organisation, presentation and care of equipment
- Ensuring health & safety procedures are followed at all times
- Supporting the warehouse in keeping equipment organised, maintained and ready for use
